### RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE AUTHOR

- The presenting author is required to make this abstract submission and is responsible for the following:
  - Presenting the content as a poster presentation only. If accepted, the top 10 posters will progress to an oral presentation.
  - Providing complete and accurate contact and affiliation information of all co-authors.
  - Assuring that all co-authors have reviewed and approved the abstract's content.
- All company presentations (i.e., groupwork/teamwork/research) must first receive permission from the company in which they were conducted. The presenting author takes full responsibility to ensure permission is granted from the company prior to submission of the abstract.

Disclosure of confidential information in the author's possession that the author needs access to, in order to use, for the disclosure purpose requires compliance with internal procedures and maintaining the privacy of company data shared, and requires ethical approvals in place to ensure there is adherence to anonymity of confidential information during submissions and/or during presentations.
