Dr Anban Pillay is Deputy Director General for Health Regulation and Compliance at South Africa's National Department of Health, where he has held senior roles for over 20 years. His work has shaped pharmaceutical policy, including medicine pricing, formularies, procurement and service delivery, as well as South Africa's Universal Health Coverage (National Health Insurance) policy and legislation.

He has served on several global health bodies, including the WHO, Medicines Patent Pool, Global Fund, UNICEF and Health Action International. During COVID-19, he played a central role in South Africa's response and co-chaired the WHO's ACT Accelerator, supporting the development, production and equitable access to COVID-19 tests, treatments and vaccines.

Dr Pillay holds a Bachelor of Pharmacy, a Master's in Clinical Pharmacology and a PhD, and has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals and book chapters.



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
